


Bonus Activity #1: Pipette by Number

Collect a piece of Parafilm, wax paper, plastic sheet protector, or Petri dish. Using the P2O, P2OO, and P10OO pipettes, recreate the designs below using water dyed with food coloring.

Bonus Activity #2: Freestyle Pipette Art

PREPARATION

- 1. Print out one or more of the following template pages and cut into quarters. Each quarter (1/4) page should feature a single art template.
- 2. Cut a plastic sheet protector into quarters. This should yield eight small 1/4's. Alternatively, you may use Petri dishes.
- 3. Prepare small cups of water dyed with food coloring.

ACTIVITY

- 1. Collect an art template and place it under a plastic sheet protector or Petri dish.
- 2. Using the P20, P200, and P1000 pipettes, recreate the design using colored water. Change droplet sizes to enhance the pipette art.
